	Course Outline	<p>The course consists of two (2) parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Part I – Basic EKG ■ Part II – EKG Monitor Tech and CET Exam Prep <p>Part I - Basic EKG:</p> <p>Course includes instruction in basic electro-physiology, preparing the patient for EKG, lead placement, sinus mechanisms, basic arrhythmias, and introduction to the 12-lead EKG.</p> <p>Part II - EKG Monitor Tech and CET Exam Prep:</p> <p>Course includes instruction in observing heart rate monitors for abnormalities, reporting significant changes in patients' heart rate and arrhythmias to nursing staff, how to study patients' charts to determine their normal heart rhythm so abnormalities are detectable and administer stress tests.</p> <p>Course also includes comprehensive instruction and practice based on exam outline and content related to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Monitoring ■ Patient Care
